The **Small Herd Initiative** helps farmers like you keep livestock out of streams. Smaller cattle operations can receive up to \$50,000 for best practices — plus ongoing technical assistance, **without competing for funding against larger operations.**

The practices benefit your farm, promoting:

- Lower rates of animal injury and disease.
- Greater weight gain in cattle, plus higher quality and quantity of milk produced.
- Less soil loss from stream bank erosion.

The Small Herd Initiative pays:

- Up to 100% for stream exclusion with buffer and grazing land management
- Up to 80% for stream protection fencing with buffer
- Per foot of portable fencing, plus charger(s)
